ANGVA 2013 Conference & Exhibition follows in the footsteps of NGV India to New Delhi

Following a trail since 2003 to Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok, Korea and Beijing the ANGVA 2013 (Asia Pacific Natural Gas Vehicles Association) Conference and Exhibition will be staged in India for the first time from 27-29 November 2013. ANGVA 2013 follows in the footsteps of the NGV India events in New Delhi in 2009 and Mumbai in 2010; the next NGV India event will be merged into ANGVA 2013, with a view to the NGV India exhibition and conference being re-scheduled in the following years.

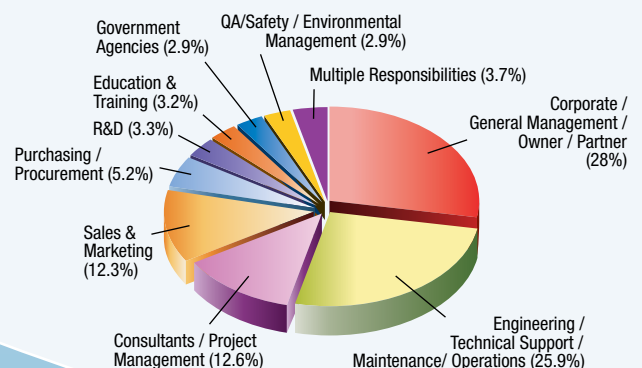

India at the heart of Asian business activity

The choice of India reflects the dynamics of a market of 1.3 billion people and:

- the 11th largest passenger car market in the world, expected to be the 7th largest by 2016.
- the 4th largest commercial vehicle market.
- the 2nd largest two wheeler market

According to SIAM (the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers) India had 1.5 million natural gas vehicles on the road in early 2012, with the number expected to reach 4 million by 2015. By 2015 the industry vision is to build out 2500 refuelling stations (up from 700) and roll out CNG networks in 100 cities (currently 40 cities).

With ten year annual growth expected to average 6.9% (source: Business Monitor International June 2012) and with strengthening ties with its immediate neighbours the ANGVA 2013 Conference and Exhibition is the perfect CNG industry platform for all South Asia and neighbouring countries.

New Delhi-the heart of the CNG story

The success of India's CNG revolution began in New Delhi, where there are currently 487,500 CNG powered vehicles, accounting for 3-4% of India's total CNG vehicle population and 5.8% of India's CNG bus numbers. Driven by strong environmental related concerns New Delhi set a path, which many leading Indian cities and states have followed.

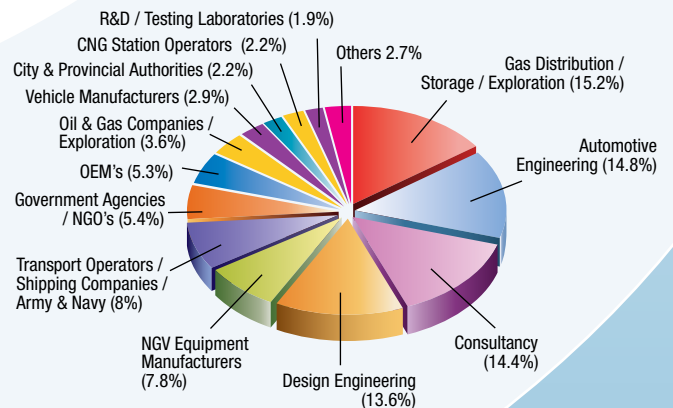

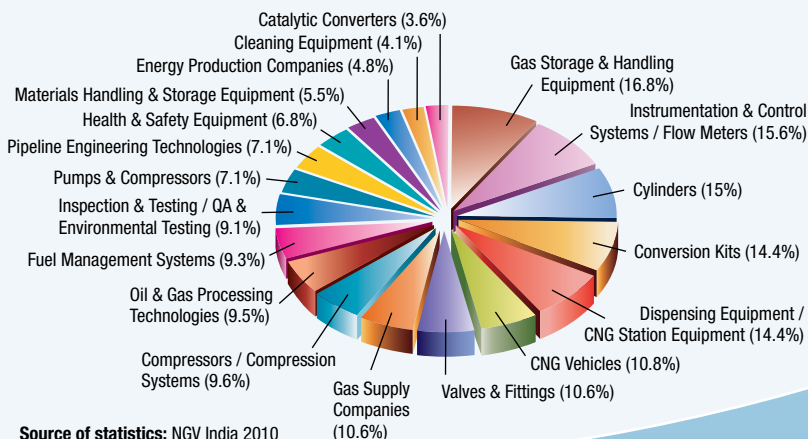

The Venue

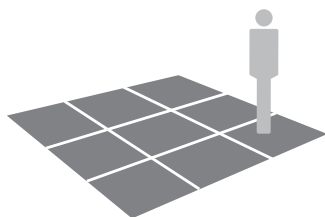


How to exhibit

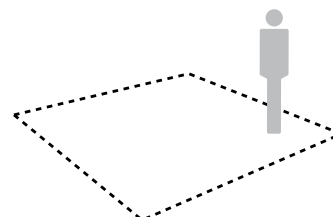
